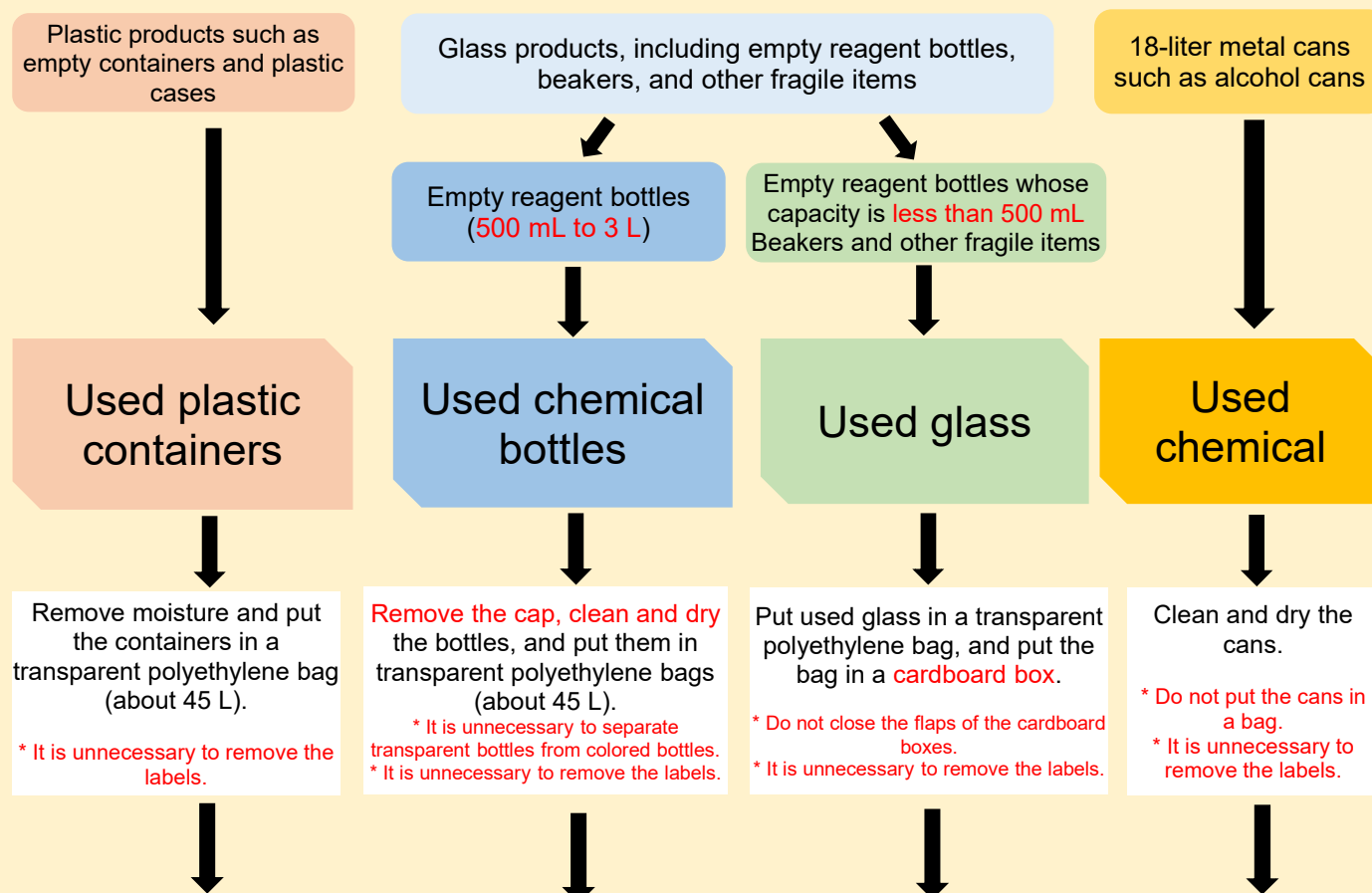


How to Separate and Dispose of Experiment-related Waste

Waste that was collected as “empty reagent bottles, etc.” previously must be separated as shown below.



- Indicate the following information on the exterior surface of a bag, cardboard box, or used chemical can.

[1] Name of the Chemical Substance Handling Group [2] Name of the person in charge [3] Contact information (extension number)

- Regarding the date and time of collection and area, etc. in the Honjo district (north, central, and south), the person in charge of each district provides information separately.

Waste cannot be collected if the above rules are not observed.
Infectious waste and waste that contains potentially infectious substances are not collected as “experiment-related waste” indicated above.
