
[Kurokami and Oe Districts] How to discharge noninfectious waste (collection of experiment waste)

[Scope]

Waste that is not infectious but is difficult to distinguish from infectious waste in appearance, or waste that contains toxic chemical substances and is hazardous when in contact

[Collection container]





Put waste in <u>collection</u> <u>containers designated by the contractor</u> and <u>cap</u> them.



[Contact information regarding distribution of collection containers] * Collection containers are delivered within three to seven business days.

* Seal the containers when discharging them.



- Indicate the following information on the exterior surface.
 [1] Name of the Chemical Substance Handling Group [2] Name of the person in charge [3] Contact information (extension number)
- Bring the waste to the collection area of respective Sections, etc. by the designated collection time on the collection date for experiment waste.
